First United Methodist Church invites artists to enter “The Art of Well-Being” competition as part of its Week of Health and Well-Being. Each artist may interpret well-being as he/she feels, and this can be in any medium except photography and digital artwork. All artwork must be original (no copies) and have been executed since January, 2010. Nudes will not be accepted. **No jewelry or crafts may be submitted. Only one entry per artist is allowed.** Artwork exhibited in previous “Art of Well-Being” Exhibits cannot be exhibited in this year’s show. Two-dimensional artwork should not exceed 48” in either direction, must be on stretched canvas or be framed, and **must have wire on the back for hanging.** Three-dimensional artwork should not exceed 48” in any direction or weigh over 30 pounds; no assembling will be done.

Artists are asked to insure their artwork while on display in the church’s Gathering Area. The First United Methodist Church will not be responsible for loss or damage. All reasonable precaution will be taken in the handling of the artwork. No commission will be taken on sold artwork. All artwork will be displayed.

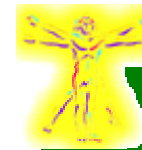

2011 marks John Steerman’s 36th year as the Director of the Evansville Museum of Arts, History and Science. In 1993, the Museum Board of Trustees raised, in a special campaign, in excess of \$600,000 to endow permanently a John W. Streetman III Director’s Chair.

Listed WHO’S WHO IN AMERICAN ART and WHO’S WHO IN AMERICA, he is a past Chairman and four-time member of the Museum Advisory Panel for the Indiana Arts Commission; past President of the Evansville Arts and Education Council; and currently serves or has served on the Boards of Directors of the University of Evansville Theatre Society, Evansville Civic Theatre, the Association of Indiana Museums, Very Special Arts of Indiana, the University of Evansville’s Harlaxton Society, The Petroleum Club, and for two terms as chairman of the society for the Arts and Humanities at the University of Southern Indiana.
